

I have been involved in the wildland fire industry both as a volunteer and as a professional for six years. In South Africa I am a divisional supervisor and firefighter, and in the United States I am crew-, fire- and engine boss trainee.

My journey into the wildfire industry was a somewhat round about and delayed entry. I initially studied Environmental Management and while completing this degree, I worked at a wonderful school in various roles, and completed my Teaching degree as well.

In 2015, Cape Town experienced a large and devastating wildfire that swept across the peninsula. I felt drawn to assist, and two years later I discovered the Volunteer Wildfire Services. Three years into my volunteer career, I was headhunted to create and lead the first all-female firefighting crew in Africa, Crew Juliet. Outside of fire season we performed fuel reductive and ecological restorative prescribed stead as I was appointed General Manager for the burns, and invasive plant species reduction projects. I have also worked as a training consultant for greater responsibility and my previous experience Vulcan Wildfire Training, helping create and teach courses focussing on the Incident Command System (ICS), fire safety, community resilience, and leadership.

> I volunteered in the US for The Nature Conservancy (TNC). I assisted various crews with prescribed burning and attended training programmes like the Missouri Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion workshops and the Women's Training Exchange (WTREX) in Virginia, as the first African and woman to attend these training events. Cumulatively I was honoured to put nearly 9000 acres of good fire back onto American soil. I was also privileged to speak as one of the only Africans in attendance at the International Association of Wildfire (IAWF) Climate and Fire Conference in Los Angeles as an Emerging International Leader, and worked on a Californian Hot Shot Crew that was deployed to Alaska for almost a month.

A substitute delegate is always welcome with written notification. No substitution fees will be charged provided notification is provided at least one week prior to the event. For standard registrations, in the event you wish to cancel your registration more than 20 days prior to commencement of the event, you agree to pay a cancellation fee of 10% of the event fee.
